



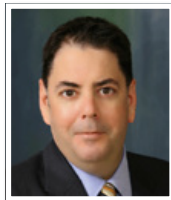

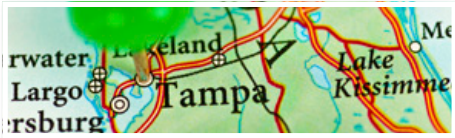

Demolition and Hazardous Materials Abatement at Ventura County Medical Center

ALLIED INDUSTRIES, INC. WAS AWARDED A \$256,000 contract with Ventura County to provide demolition, and asbestos and lead abatement of their Medical Center.

The work will include demolition of structures within the footprint of the buildings; locating, cutting and capping sewer lines; demolition of athletic courts including fencing, footings and lighting; saw cut and removal of asphalt; removal of trees, shrubs, sod, and other vegetation; and abatement and disposal of lead and asbestos containing materials per the survey reports.

Asbestos Abatement at Brookhaven Office Building in Dallas, TX

ALLIED INDUSTRIES, INC. PERFORMED asbestos abatement at one 50,000 square foot building and two 100,000+ square foot buildings located at the Intersection of Josey Lane and Lyndon B. Johnson (LBJ) Freeway in Dallas on a Texas Department of Transportation contract. The prime contractor was F. Hall Mowing. Buildings 2915, 2925 and 3001 were property of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT). The buildings were slated for abatement and demolition as part of the LBJ Expressway expansion project, and Allied was called to mobilize within 24 hours of award.

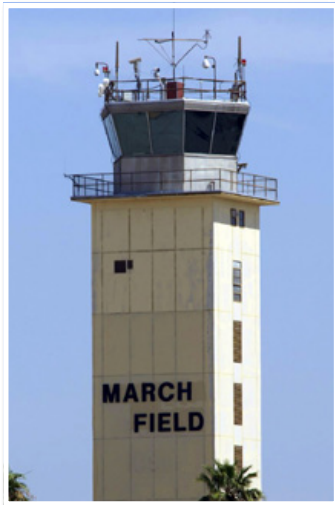
Best value practices were utilized, and included minimization of waste volume and associated disposal costs. As such, Allied developed a new method of waste movement to increase the crew's efficiency and minimize the number of asbestos contaminated waste hauls required, resulting in an overall cost savings for the Owner and beating our proposed schedule of 28 days. The project was successfully completed in 20 days.

Emergency Procedure 5, Asbestos Abatement at March Air Reserve Base, Riverside, CA

ALLIED INDUSTRIES, INC. WAS AWARDED a firm-fixed-price Asbestos Abatement contract at March Air Reserve Base in Riverside, CA. The scope of this project is to provide complete removal of asbestos containing materials throughout the 22,000 SF attic space and below-floor crawlspace. In addition, 22,000 SF of asbestos contaminated insulation will be removed utilizing the Allied owned VecLoader vacuum truck system. After removal of the attic insulation, Allied workers will thoroughly decontaminate the attic space utilizing HEPA vacuuming and wet wipe procedures. The time allotted for the entire abatement project is 30 to 40 working days and Allied is slated for an on time completion.budget.
